

NORTH MIAMI ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SUMMER READING PLAN

With the end of the school year upon us, we know that you are making plans for your child's summer vacation activities. While the summer months are a welcome opportunity for fun and relaxation, the break from school activities often causes students to experience a lag in learning upon returning to school in the fall.

Miami-Dade County Public Schools is implementing a Summer Reading program for all students in grades Kindergarten-12th grade North Miami Elementary School will be following MDCPS's *K-12 Summer Reading Guidelines*. The chart below lists the grade levels and required readings that should be completed before the start of the 2022-2023 school year. At least two fiction books have been selected for each grade. In addition to those two books, students are to select one nonfiction or informational book on a topic of interest to them. Free access to eBooks and audiobooks can be found at read.dadeschools.net. For each book that the children read, there is an assigned activity that will be collected in August during the first week of school. All students who submit completed activities will be invited to the **SUMMER READING CELEBRATION** when they return in the Fall!

In addition, please keep in mind that the MyON Reading program via the student portal will also be available for student use throughout the entire summer. We highly recommend the program for all students to continue their reading routines.

Puede encontrar acceso gratuito a libros electrónicos y audiolibros en read.dadeschools.net. Por cada libro que leen los niños hay una actividad asignada que se recogerá en agosto durante la primera semana de clases. ¡Todos los estudiantes que envíen actividades completadas serán invitados a la CELEBRACIÓN DE LECTURA DE VERANO cuando regresen en el otoño!

Además, tenga en cuenta que el programa de lectura MyON a través del portal para estudiantes también estará disponible para uso de los estudiantes durante todo el verano. Recomendamos encarecidamente el programa para que todos los estudiantes continúen con sus rutinas de lectura.

<i>Pup's Prairie Home</i>	Redmond, Shirley Raye	Make a picture timeline or a Tree Map of all the events in the book, including beginning, middle and end.
1 nonfiction book of your choice		Write a sentence summarizing the information from the book.

<i>The Teacher Who Forgot Too Much</i>	Brezenoff, Steve	Choose a character and create an illustration with adjectives describing the character or a Bubble Map describing the character. Tell whether or not you would want him/her for a sibling, parent, friend, or partner (choose one) and explain why in one short paragraph.

<i>A Horse on the Hill: A Story of Ancient India</i>	Gunderson, Jessica	Write a book review (include a brief summary, a rating, and a recommendation).

<i>S.M.A.R.T.S. and the Poison Plates</i>	Metz, Melinda	Make a poster on a (8 ½ x 11) paper advertising your book so someone else will want to read it.
<i>Turtle Summer: A Journal for my Daughter</i>	Monroe, Mary Alice	Create a timeline of the major events in your book using a Flow Map. Use drawings or magazine cutouts to show the events along the timeline. Label each event.
1 nonfiction book of your choice		Write 2-3 paragraphs summarizing the information from the book, including the most important facts described by the author.

<i>Holes</i>	Louis Sachar	Create a character diary and write at least five journal entries as if you are the main character in the story. Write down events that happen during the story and reflect on how they affected the character and why.
<i>My Father's Dragon</i>	Gannett, Ruth Stiles	Create a Top Ten List. On this list of ten, write or illustrate ten things you have learned from the book.
<i>Frindle</i>	Andrew Clements	Create a Flow Map. Write down events that happen during the story and reflect on how they affected the character and why.
1 nonfiction book of your choice		Write a report summarizing the information from the book, including the most important facts described by the author. (Each fact should be summarized in one paragraph.)
